

Protect Yourself. Protect Your Family. Protect Your Church Community. Get Your COVID-19 Vaccination.

In our faith community, we look out for and protect one another. Getting the COVID-19 vaccine adds one more layer of protection for you, your family, and your church family. Everyone who is eligible to get the vaccine should get fully vaccinated - especially older adults who are at greater risk from complications of the virus than younger people. Because our elders, specifically African Americans, have much higher rates of chronic conditions like diabetes, heart disease, high blood pressure and obesity, they can have greater complications if they get the COVID virus. So, it's important that everyone is fully vaccinated – young and old alike – to keep the virus from further harming our community.

Can the COVID-19 vaccine give you the coronavirus?

No. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) the COVID-19 vaccinations cannot give you the virus. They are safe and effective. You may experience mild side effects such as headache, sore arm, and not feeling well a day or two after getting the vaccination), but that is normal.

How much does COVID-19 vaccination cost?

It's free to all people living in the United States, regardless of their immigration or health insurance status. You **cannot** be charged for the COVID-19 vaccine.

How do I get a vaccine?

There are several places that you can get your COVID-19 vaccination including pharmacies, health clinics and even pop-up vaccination events. If you are unsure about where to get vaccinated, contact your church office or the General Baptist State Convention of WI headquarters at (414) 264-6869.
